Dianella BluTopia[™]





General:

A tough clumping Dianella with broad blue foliage and showy greyed-red peduncles bearing deep purple buds that open to reveal loads of small violet-blue flowers in late spring.



Form & Habit:

- 24" $\rm H\,x\,20"\,W\,(+/-)$; Evergreen $\rm w/$ upright foliage
- Quick to finish & fast to establish in the landscape
- Zones 9 -11; plant in a protected area in colder climates



Leaf & Bloom:

- Broad strap-like foliage with a look similar to Phormium; blue-gray color
- Branched inflorescence with loads of small violet-blue flowers in late spring; non-fragrant



Notes:

- Plant in well-drained soils; full sun to light shade
- Drought tolerant once established
- Remove spent inflorescence and untidy foliage as desired, at any time of year
