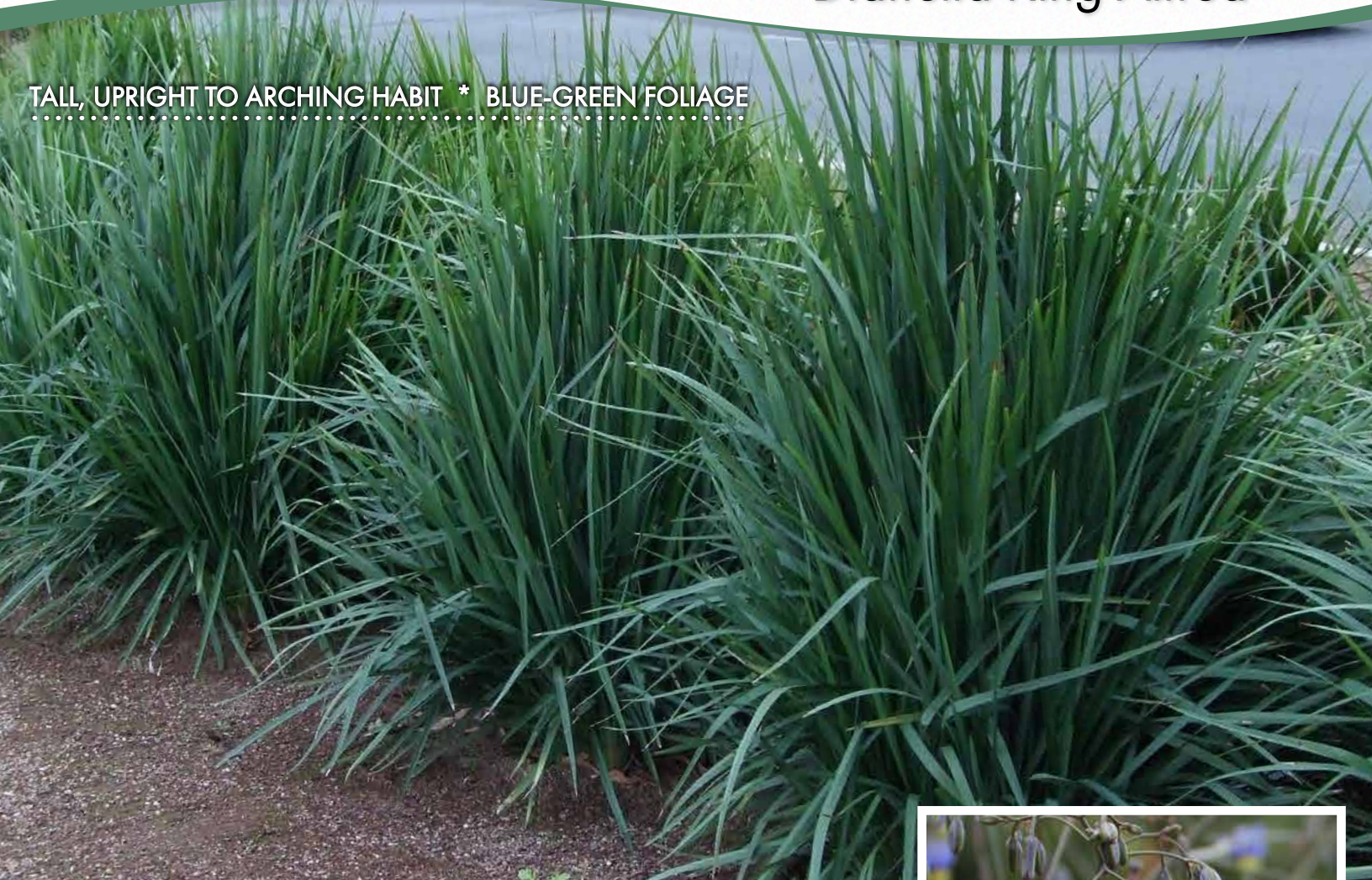


Dianella King Alfred™

TALL, UPRIGHT TO ARCHING HABIT * BLUE-GREEN FOLIAGE



Dianella caerulea 'JOHN316' King Alfred™ PP20,794



General: A tall, upright to arching Dianella with a clumping habit and blue-green glaucous foliage. A vigorous grower, King Alfred is quick to establish and deeply rooting.



Form & Habit:

- 30" H x 24" W (+/-); Evergreen w/ upright foliage
- Quick to finish & fast to establish in the landscape
- Zones 9 -11; plant in a protected area in colder climates



Leaf & Bloom:

- Broad strap-like foliage; blue-green and glaucous with pronounced red coloration at the base.
- Branched inflorescence with loads of small violet-blue flowers in late spring; non-fragrant



Notes:

- Plant in well-drained soils; full sun to light shade
- Drought tolerant once established
- Remove spent inflorescence and untidy foliage as desired, at any time of year
