

Hardenbergia Meema™

SUB-SHRUB HABIT * HEAVY BLOOMER * EXTENDED BLOOM PERIOD



Hardenbergia violacea 'HB01.08' MEEMA PP25,657



General: Meema maintains a sub-shrub habit with only minimal pruning, compared to the typical vining habit, with loads of violet flower clusters covering the plant in late winter.



Form & Habit:

- 4 ft H x 4-5 ft W (+/-); evergreen sub-shrub
- Moderately fast growing
- USDA Hardiness Zones 9-11



Leaf & Bloom:

- Narrow elliptical evergreen leaves; emerald green with a leathery texture
- Deep violet "pea" flowers with clustered into terminal inflorescence that appear in great numbers from late winter to early spring.



Notes:

- Shrubby habit negates the need for staking
- More flowers with a longer bloom period
- Long-lived
