COMPACT * STRIKING VARIEGATION * RED-PINK BASAL ACCENTS



Dianella tasmanica 'TAS100' Destiny™ PP19,338



General: A compact, tightly-clumping form of Dianella with striking variegation; more vivid, with higher color contrast when compared to the common variegated form. Hues of red-pink radiate up from the plant's base.



Form & Habit:

- 1.5' H x 1.5' W (+/-); compact, arched habit
- Tightly clumping crown creates a dense tussock
- Zones 8 -11; arid to subtropical climates; plant in a protected area in colder climates.



Leaf & Bloom:

- Broad, sword-like foliage with bold variegation
- Branched inflorescences sit above the foliage, each with many small blue flowers. Flowers in spring.



Notes:

- Plant in filtered sun to moderately heavy shade
- Prefers free draining soils
- Prune as needed to rejuvenate the foliage
